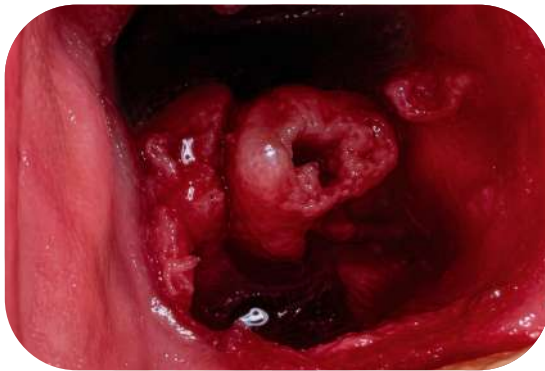
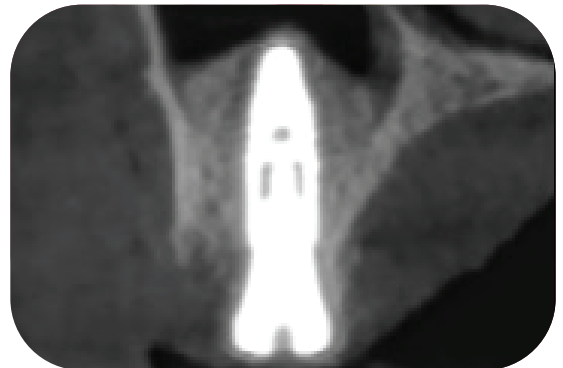


Jake Wolf
